

Music of the Spheres (solution)

Each musical excerpt includes a single syllable in its lyrics which is a homophone of a letter:

- **E**-del-weiss (sounds like **A**)
- **G**ee, Off-i-cer Krup-ke (**G**)
- Hap-**py** birth-day... (**P**)
- It's the **eye** of the tiger... (**I**)
- ...Nathan, **De**-troit (**D**)
- **Oh**, Susanna! (**O**)
- ...That's **en**-ertainment! (**N**)
- Some **en**-chanted evening (**N**)
- ...Twelve, fifteen, **eigh**-teen (**A**)
- We **are** the world (**R**)

Most of the songs have been transposed from their original keys, but this knowledge is not necessary to solve the puzzle. However, in the given keys, the notes corresponding to the letter syllables all have unique pitches. Arrange those pitches in the order of the “circle of fifths” as given on the first page, and the letters spell the answer, **GRAND PIANO**.
