Martha Stewart had a lot of special guests on her show over the years, but one of the most notable was the episode where a former welterweight champion, Tony [1E], "The [5N] & [22E] of Fleet Street" welcomed her to Boston's North End by challenging her to a fight. They started at a statue of his likeness on Hanover Street, and, with wry tangles and left hooks, the boxer and baker moved across the field like unchecked knights.

In their grid of competition, each entry makes a 90° turn somewhere along its length. Each entry's starting square and starting direction (North, East, South, or West) are given, as well as the direction in which the entry turns. All letters are used by two entries except for the ones used for the puzzle's answer, and those unchecked letters do not share any row or column with each other.
