

While there are 52 words in the list, there are only 26 blanks. The words on the word list can be paired to determine which 26 words should be entered in the grid. For each word pair, the clued word is one letter different from one of the words on the word list and its meaning is clued by one of the other words on the list. For example, WOODINESS can become WORDINESS, clued by VERBOSITY.

Entering these 26 words into the grid, the letter changes used to form these words highlight 13 intersections (where at each intersection the same letter change was used).



Reading the letters in these 13 intersections using the 26 words entered in directly from the word list spells out the hazard TWAIN CROSSING. The letters at these intersections after being changed spell out the message ANSWER TRAITOR.
